  - ISBN: 978-1419712180
  - This book is about a young genius who loves figuring out how the world works by creating household contraptions that are part science, part imagination and definitely unusual.

- **The Wild Robot** by: Peter Brown
  - ISBN: 978-0316581097
  - **The Wild Robot** is the story of Roz, a robot who wakes up alone on a remote island and must learn how to survive in the wild. As she adapts to her new environment, Roz discovers the power of curiosity, kindness, and community.
