 - ISBN: 978-1510108967
 - Brief synopsis: When Zak's grandmother moves into his room, he declares war with a series of clever pranks—but his new opponent is much trickier than he expected. As unexpected changes begin to affect his grandmother, Zak learns powerful lessons about family, compassion, and the memories that connect generations.
- **The Wild Robot** by: Peter Brown
 - ISBN: 978-0316581097
 - **Brief synopsis:** Roz is a robot who wakes up alone on a remote island and must learn how to survive in the wild. As she adapts to her new environment, Roz discovers the power of curiosity, kindness, and community.
